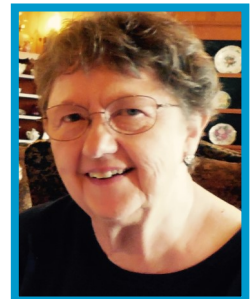
LIFE: An Invigorating Month Awaits You!
